Or what mission money could go to...

\$25 for 1 week of healthy snacks for expanding programming in the building

\$300 or a snow-blower to keep our sidewalks clear and safe during the winter months

\$150 for 1 Sunday evening meal made from fresh and healthy foods in a food insecure context

\$100 for the internet service for one month

\$100 or art supplies for one month of programming, serving 30-40 adults and 50-80 youth

\$350 or 4 new or used dehumidifiers (2 donated by Forest Grove Presbyterian Church)

\$100 or 1 high yield toner cartridge for Brother MFC 8710DW

\$500 or a reliable lawnmower-pusher (2 volunteer hours), once every other week for the full grass growing season
